



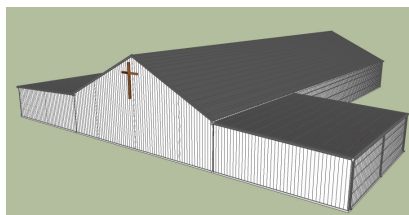
Hear Our Prayers, O Lord

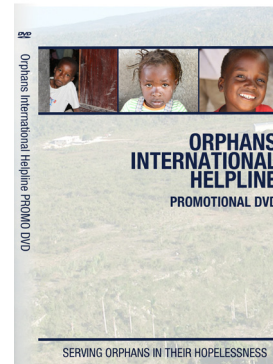
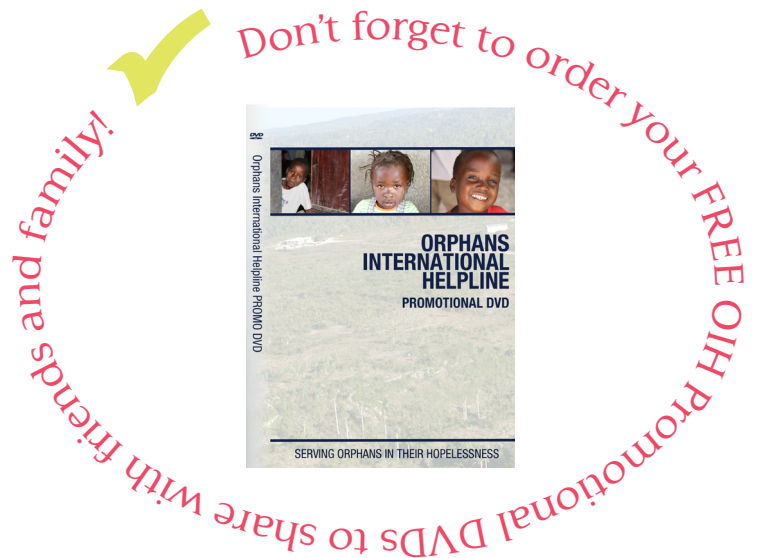

To eliminate the cost of renting transportation each time missionaries go to the OIH facility in Haiti, or when we need to transport the children anywhere, the board approved the purchase of a mini school bus. Once again, an offer was made below the asking price.



Initially OIH was told their offer would not be accepted because other offers had already been received that exceeded ours, and they had been rejected. The OIH board once again prayed for God's will to be done.

Several days later the school selling the bus called, indicating their board had discussed OIH and would like to sell the bus to us at our offered price.
